Easy/Inexpensive

- ❖ warm-colored beanbag chairs or similar relaxed chairs for cloister (\$50-70 each from www.beanproducts.com)
- ❖ adopt one of our students for regular prayer (priceless)

Moderate

- ❖ Small (22” long) candle-lighter/snuffer from CM Almy (product number ST913)(\$120)
- ❖ Attractive fence around AC unit (\$300?)
- ❖ 1 or 2 dehumidifiers for basement (\$150-200 each)
- ❖ Wii (\$200), extra Wiimotes (\$40 each), and Wii games (\$30-60 each)
- ❖ Porch-swing for the front porch (\$300?)
