Easy/Inexpensive

- ❖ Fun, simple board games (Fluxx, poker chips, Dicecapades, Connect 4, etc.) (\$20 each)
- ❖ DVDs (*Battlestar Galactica*, *Keeping the Faith*, *Firefly*, *Last Temptation of Christ*, *Big Lebowski*, *Lars and the Real Girl*, *Dogville*, *Waitress*, *Up*, *Contact*, etc.) (\$20-50 each)
- ❖ second-hand or fairly-traded kitchen towels and dish cloths—fun colors (free-\$15)
- ❖ beaded curtains for “tiki”-style basement décor (\$10/string)
- ❖ warm-colored beanbag chairs or similar relaxed chairs for cloister (\$50-70 each from www.beanproducts.com)

Moderate

- ❖ solar stake lights x 8 (\$80-280, depending on quality)
- ❖ Shelving in chapel closet (\$150?)
- ❖ Attractive fence around AC unit (\$300?)
- ❖ Reupholster Alice’s visitor’s chairs (\$600)
- ❖ 2 or 3 dehumidifiers for basement (\$150-200 each)
- ❖ Wii (\$200), extra Wiimotes (\$40 each), and Wii games (\$30-60 each)
- ❖ Soft throw rug at least 5’x8’ for TV room (desert colors, perhaps similar to: <http://www.ikea.com/us/en/catalog/products/30097109>) (\$150-300)

Difficult/Costly

- ❖ Recycled plastic bicycle rack (~\$625)—as much post-consumer plastic as possible
- ❖ Plants/landscaping for side yard around the Listening Bench—native Ohio species (priceless)
- ❖ Paint outside of upper story of house—mural? (priceless)
- ❖ Commission artist Jill Hicks to do table tops in the house—particularly the two half-rounds and/or the two side tables in the living room (\$600)
- ❖ Kitchen redesign—in consultation with Chuck Darling and/or Hank Hildebrandt (priceless)
- ❖ Deck on back of house over driveway (\$3,000)
- ❖ New gutters
- ❖ Sectional sofa for meeting room—has to get up narrow, twisty staircase (priceless)
